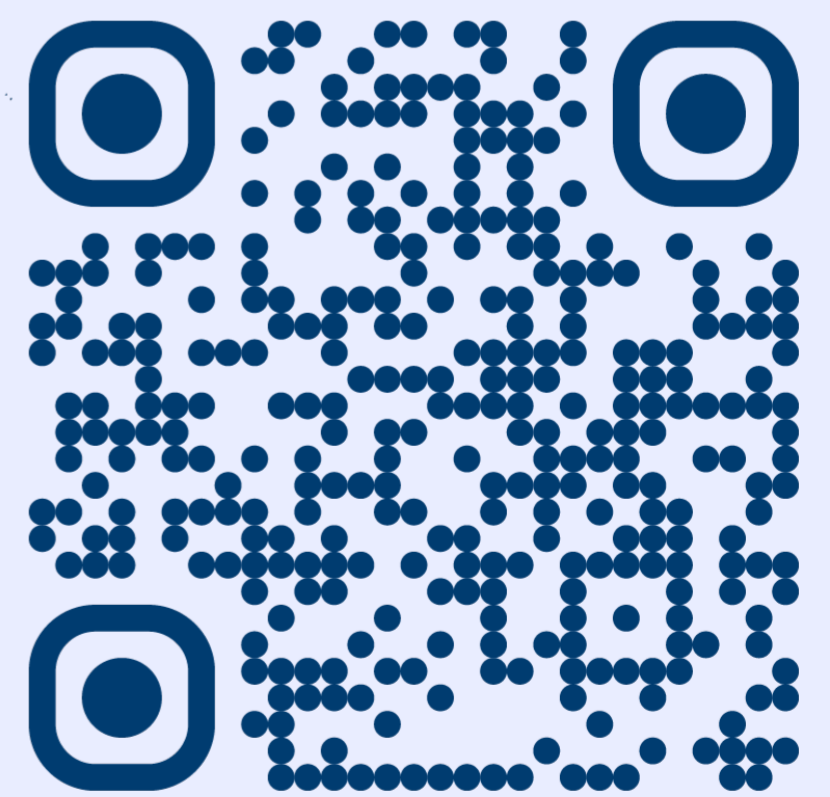

A clinical trial looking at PCR based diagnostics, fluid therapy and GM-CSF for sepsis in Critical Care (SepTiC).

Sepsis is a life-threatening condition that arises when the body's response to an infection causes it to attack its own tissues and organs and is a major healthcare problem. Investigators at Imperial College London are investigating three interventions in adult patients admitted into the ICU with suspected sepsis and **we are currently recruiting on this unit.**
