REMINDER - EQ-5D Telephone Questionnaire to be completed on paper

The EQ-5D telephone questionnaire conducted at Day 180 must be printed off and completed on paper during the conversation with the participant. The answers will then be entered into OpenClinica. This is to ensure the questionnaire is being conducted in line with the EQ-5D requirements which includes the full telephone script.

The paper questionnaire should be filed in the ISF as source data.
